



Campus Life Small Group Leader

Job Description:

The Campus Life Small Group Leader will be responsible for leading a small group of 4-12 students using YFC curriculum at the site in which they serve. These groups will typically meet at a predetermined location for 6-8 weeks each.

Purpose of Role:

The Campus Life Ministry is looking for individuals who will serve in one of our locations by leading groups of 4-12 students through YFC small group curriculum, centered around a Biblical topic, the Gospel itself, or a relevant life issue. Based on the life and ministry of Jesus with His disciples, we believe that these small groups are an essential part of spiritual development for our young people.

Pre-requisites:

1. A passion for the mission of campus life; to reach youth in North East Ohio and provide a Christ-centered, one on one relationship to each youth
2. Prior point of entry attendance (i.e. Campus life See the Story Tour)
3. Ability to commit time on a weekly basis (unless otherwise specified by site director)
4. Desire to work with young people in a small group setting
5. Structured ability to facilitate these groups each week

Roles and Responsibilities:

1. Foster relationships with students in the group
2. Prepare lesson and program (game/icebreaker) in advance of group
3. Send reminders to participants in group
4. Use YFC curriculum to lead group (unless otherwise directed)
5. Prepare materials (food, games, other necessary materials) in advance of group (unless otherwise directed)
6. Commit to praying for students in the group
7. Other duties specifically assigned
