## **DESCRIPTION**

The role of the City Life Ministry Staff is to be a minister of the Gospel and engage adults in authentic Christ-sharing relationships with lost teens. This should be accomplished through modeling direct ministry with teens, coordinating opportunities for volunteers to enter in to the lives of teens, and supporting/training those volunteers in their ministry roles.

Assist with an extensive programming model in the neighborhood of Clark-Fulton through clubs, events, camp, small groups, mentoring and leadership development:

- Develop partnerships with neighborhood organizations, churches, and schools
- Assist with fundraising for the City Life ministry
- Recruit, train, empower and retain a robust volunteer team
- Assist with training church teams and volunteers in inner city youth issues
- Assist the volunteer ministry leaders in developing authentic Christ sharing relationships
- Spiritually lead students and leaders through prayer, bible study, and life on life ministry

### **Fundraising Responsibilities**

All YFC employees are involved in the Stewardship functions of YFC/USA and Greater Cleveland YFC. These responsibilities may include developing personal donor relationships, assisting with "See the Story" tours, "Be the Story" fundraising events, and other fundraising activities.

### **Spiritual Responsibilities**

Because the purpose and mission of Youth for Christ USA is to communicate and introduce the Gospel of Jesus Christ to young people and their families, and in that regard to make, educate and encourage life-long disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ, it is very important that you as an employee in the movement of Youth for Christ be recognized as a dedicated disciple of Christ.

- Seek God's guidance and wisdom, through prayer and meditation for the organization as a whole as well as for specific ministry initiatives.
- Participate and lead regular times of prayer, devotion and worship as a regular aspect of your role within YFC.
- Teach and preach from the Holy Bible at YFC staff meetings, conferences, camps and events.

Additionally, YFC employees will have an opportunity to be commissioned or licensed as a minister of the Gospel through the established Youth for Christ process.

- Have or willing to develop an extensive understanding of under-resourced neighborhoods and diversity awareness
- Fluent in Spanish language preferred but not necessary
- Proficient in basic computer skills and Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Publisher, etc.)
- Knowledgeable in different social media sites
- Ministry Experience is a plus
