



Gracehaven Ambassador Volunteer Job Description

Ambassadors are short-term volunteers that serve for a project or for a season to open doors for Gracehaven in the community. Ambassadors introduce new people to Gracehaven by hosting and/or filling a point of entry event with ten or more guests. Ambassadors also sponsor and/or direct short term projects that advance the mission of Gracehaven.

Pre-requisites:

- A passion for the mission of Gracehaven; to eradicate child sex trafficking in Northeast Ohio and provide rehabilitative, trauma-informed care to survivors.
- Prior point of entry attendance (i.e. Gracehaven Info Session, Gracehaven Lunch/Dinner)

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Hosts and fills a private point of entry event for ten or more guests within 3 months of agreeing to become a Gracehaven Ambassador.
- Informs guests of what the point of entry will be about, that they will receive a follow-up call from Gracehaven, and that they will not be asked for money.
- Aims to have at least one of their attendees also become an Ambassador after a point of entry event.
- Invites 10 people to Gracehaven's free annual fundraising event, "**Comedy Café**" on **October 19th, 2018** at Parkside Church.
- Manages short-term project (such as Gracehaven Survivor Kit acquisition) with a defined start and end date.
- Coordinates Prayer requests to the Volunteer Prayer Coordinator

Length of Service:

Ambassadors will complete their commitment of hosting and filling a point of entry with ten or more guests within three months. Ambassador has the option to complete one term, continue for another term, or get involved in other ways.
