



Gracehaven Prayer Partners/Coordinator Job Description

Prayer Partners/Coordinators have a passion for people and for the mission of Gracehaven, so they are able to gather people together to pray for needs of the ministry, staff and volunteers. Prayer Partners/Coordinators serve for a specific time period as determined by the volunteer and the Gracehaven Community Outreach Director. Prayer Partner/Coordinators gather prayer needs and requests from other volunteer coordinators and staff via email or phone and conduct a bi-monthly conference call prayer session with participants.

Pre-requisites:

- A passion for the mission of Gracehaven; to eradicate child sex trafficking in Northeast Ohio and provide rehabilitative, trauma-informed care to survivors.
- Prior point of entry attendance (i.e. Gracehaven Info Session, Gracehaven Lunch/Dinner)
- Excellent written grammar and an ability to communicate well.
- Excellent telephone skills and an ability to listen well.
- Faith

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Follows up with all Gracehaven volunteers and staff to gather prayer needs and requests (Coordinator)
- Attends and/or Coordinates bi-monthly prayer conference call and provides call in number
- Sends email invitations to Gracehaven prayer participants (Coordinator)
- Calls invitees to remind/invite to Gracehaven prayer events as needed

Length of Service:

The Prayer Coordinator will provide services for a pre-determined time period individually determined by Gracehaven needs and volunteer's availability. Prayer Coordinators have the option to complete one term, renew another term, or to help other ways.
