



## **Juvenile Justice Ministry (JJM) Chapel Worship Leader**

### **Job Description:**

Chapel Worship Leaders will work closely with our JJM chapel director by choosing music and on occasion leading worship before and after the Wednesday chapel service.

### **Purpose of Role:**

Chapel Worship Leaders will help with predetermining worship song choices and with any other needs for the Wednesday Chapel Service as predetermined by the JJM Chapel Director. They can also help lead in worship predetermined by the chapel director. They can network with our guests and volunteers before and at the end of the Wednesday chapel service. They will also give any prayer requests received from the youth to the chapel prayer coordinator

### **Pre-requisites:**

1. A passion for the mission of JJM; to reach every incarcerated youth in North East Ohio and provide a Christ-centered, one on one relationship to each youth
2. Prior point of entry attendance (i.e. JJM See the Story Tour)
3. Excellent ability to communicate well.
4. Must be able to play an instrument
5. Availability on Wednesday evenings from 5:50– 8:30 pm

### **Roles and Responsibilities:**

1. Will arrive early to the correctional facility in order to help set up sound and help with any other requirements for chapel service
2. Coordinates all prayer requests directly to the chapel prayer coordinator
3. Connect with the volunteers and the youth before or after chapel service
4. Connects periodically with the chapel director during the week before Wednesday

### **Length of Service:**

The chapel worship leader will provide services for a pre-determined time period individually determined by JJM needs and volunteer's availability. The chapel worship leader will have the option to complete one term, renew another term, or to help other ways.
